Before first use, always double-check to ensure that all packaging materials have been removed from your appliance.



DON'T BE ALARMED. New parts might have a smell when first heated, but it will fade after a few uses. This is completely normal.

IMPORTANT SAFEGUARDS

PLEASE READ ALL INSTRUCTIONS CAREFULLY BEFORE USING THIS APPLIANCE. WHEN USING ELECTRICAL APPLIANCES, ALWAYS FOLLOW BASIC SAFETY PRECAUTIONS. INCLUDING THE FOLLOWING:

- · Do not touch hot surfaces. Always use handles or knobs.
- Do not immerse the cord or plug in water or any other liquid to avoid the risk of electric shock.
- This toaster should only be used by, or under the supervision of, a responsible adult.
- Suitable for children aged 8 and above. However, cleaning and maintenance should only be performed by adults.
- Keep the appliance and cord out of reach of children.
- Always unplug the toaster and allow it to cool before cleaning or handling any parts.
- If the appliance is damaged or malfunctioning, stop using it immediately and replace it. Do not use it
 with a damaged cord or plug.
- Use only accessories recommended by the manufacturer to avoid injury.
- For indoor use only. Do not use outdoors.
- Do not allow the power cord to hang over the edge of tables or countertops or come into contact with hot surfaces.
- Keep the appliance away from heat sources such as burners, ovens, and hotplates.
- Ensure all controls are in the "off" position before unplugging the toaster.
- Only use the toaster for its intended purpose.
- Do not insert oversized items, foil-wrapped food, or utensils into the toaster as this may cause fire or electric shock.
- Keep the toaster away from curtains, drapes, walls, and any flammable materials during use.
- Never attempt to remove jammed bread while the toaster is plugged in.
- Do not use the toaster in bathrooms or expose it to water.
- Always place the toaster on a flat, stable, heat-resistant surface and keep it out of children's reach.
- CAUTION: The area around the toasting slots becomes hot during use. Do not touch.
- Never cover the toasting slots while the toaster is hot or in use.
- Do not toast buttered bread or sandwiches in the toaster.

- If bread gets jammed, unplug the toaster, let it cool, and gently remove the bread.
 DO NOT USE SHARP OBJECTS.
- · Avoid using torn, curled, or misshapen slices as they may jam the toaster.
- · Always unplug and let the toaster cool after use.
- Clean out crumbs regularly to prevent buildup and fire hazards.
- Only use the toaster with the crumb tray closed and properly in place.
- Do not use the toaster with external timers or remote controls.
- Only use the appliance as described in this manual.
- This appliance has a polarized plug (one prong is wider than the other) to reduce the risk of electric shock. The plug will fit only one way into a polarized outlet. If it doesn't fit, reverse it. If it still doesn't fit, consult a qualified electrician. Do not modify the plug.


POWER SUPPLY SAFETY

- Before first use, confirm that your outlet's voltage matches the rating label on the toaster.
- Only connect the toaster to an outlet with a proper grounding feature.
- Fully unwind the power cord to avoid overheating.
- Do not let the power cord hang over edges of tables or counters.
- Use a short power cord and arrange it to prevent entanglement or tripping. Avoid using extension cords. If necessary, have a grounded outlet installed by a qualified electrician.
- · Do not place the cord under heavy objects or cover it.
- Ensure the cord is not bent or crushed, particularly at connection points.
- Always unplug the toaster when not in use, when malfunctioning, or before cleaning or storing.
- Always unplug by pulling the plug, not the cord.
- Do not plug in or operate the toaster with wet hands or while standing in water.
- Keep the power cord and appliance away from open flames and hot surfaces.
- This toaster features a polarized plug for safety. Follow the same user guidelines as in IMPORTANT SAFEGUARDS above.

KEEP THESE INSTRUCTIONS FOR FUTURE REFERENCE HOW TO USE

DESCRIPTION OF PARTS

- 1. Toasting slots
- 2. Loading handle
- 3. CANCEL button
- 4. BAGEL button
- 5. **DEFROST** button
- 6. Browning control knob
- 7. Crumb tray
- 8. Glass window



BEFORE FIRST USE

- · Inspect the toaster to ensure all parts are intact and undamaged.
- Turn the browning control knob to the highest setting and operate the toaster without bread once. This
 will condition the heating elements.
- A slight odor may be noticeable this is normal. Ensure good ventilation during this process. Inspect
 the toaster to ensure all parts are intact and undamaged.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

MAKING TOAST:

- Place the toaster upright on a stable, level, heat-resistant surface.
- Plug it in and turn on the socket if necessary. The light around the button will illuminate.
- Set the desired browning level using the knob. A higher number gives darker toast.

- Insert bread slices (max thickness 20 mm) into the slots.
- Push down the bread carriage handle until it locks. It will only lock if the toaster is plugged in.
- The toaster will begin heating and toasting.
- · When finished, the toast will pop up and the heating will stop automatically.

DEFROST BUTTON:

- To toast frozen bread, select your desired browning level, insert the frozen bread, lower the loading handle, and press the defrost button.
- The light will turn on and toasting time will automatically adjust.

CANCELLATION FUNCTION:

 To stop the toasting process at any time, press the cancel button. The toast will pop up, heating will stop, and the light will turn off.

BAGEL BUTTON:

• Use this feature to toast only one side of the bread (ideal for bagels).

TIPS FOR BEST RESULTS

- Toast slices of similar size, thickness, and freshness for even results.
- Older bread contains less moisture and will toast more quickly.
- Thin or old bread needs a lower setting.
- Sweet breads (e.g., tea cakes, fruit loaf) brown quickly use a lower setting.

CARE AND MAINTENANCE

- Always unplug the toaster and let it cool completely before cleaning.
- Wipe the exterior with a soft, damp cloth.
- Do not insert any objects into the slots this may damage internal parts.
- Avoid abrasive cleaners and solvents.
- Never immerse the toaster in water or any liquid.

CRUMB REMOVAL

- Clean out the crumbs often to keep the toaster clean and safe. Too many crumbs can cause a fire.
- · After unplugging and cooling, remove the crumb tray, empty it, and wipe it clean.
- Dry thoroughly and reinsert securely before operating the toaster again.
- Never use the toaster without the crumb tray in place.

QUICK START

- Plug the toaster into an electrical outlet.
- Insert your toast or bagel into the slots.
- Adjust the browning level using the 1-6 shade knob.
- Press down the toast lever to begin toasting.
- To stop toasting at any time, press the cancel button.
- For bagels, press the bagel button.
- To defrost frozen bread, press the defrost button.
